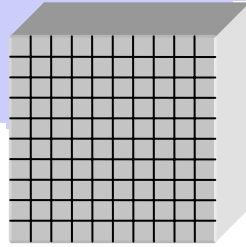

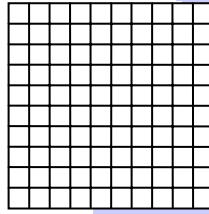
“What Number am I?”

1. You have six base ten blocks. Some of them are tens and some are ones. Their total is less than 20. “What Number am I?”
2. You have 9 base ten blocks. Some of them are tens and some are ones. Their total is an even number between 50 and 60. “What Number am I?”
3. You have five base ten blocks. Some of them are tens and some are ones. Their total is between 40 and 50. “What Number am I?”
4. You have five base ten blocks. Some are hundreds, some are tens, and some are ones. I am the same written forwards as I am backwards. “What Number am I?”

5. You have two base ten blocks. “What Number am I?”
6. You have three base ten blocks. None of these are hundreds. “What Number am I?”
7. You have four base ten blocks. None of these are tens. “What Number am I?”
