

## The Reading Lab at Henry Ford Community College, Winter 2010 - ROOM LRC-211

### INTRODUCTION

The Reading Lab at HFCC is part of the Learning Lab which includes writing and math. Like most such labs, the Reading Lab provides a learning environment with an abundance of materials at all levels of difficulty, with various approaches, and with sufficient staff to help students help themselves.

### PURPOSE

The Reading Lab is designed to assist all HFCC students who need help with their reading problems, from remedial to advanced. The lab is not only intended for students enrolled in English courses. Any HFCC student, part-time, or full-time, may use our services on a drop-in or referral basis. There is no charge.

### PROGRAMS

Rate, comprehension, vocabulary, and spelling programs are available at various levels. The study materials include software, controlled readers, audio tapes, programmed cards, programmed books and traditional texts.

Although a reading teacher will be available during the hours posted below, the programs were chosen for the independent learner. The student's program will be based on diagnostic testing to improve both his strengths and weaknesses. If a student has a personal goal in, say, vocabulary, he may pursue it according to his own schedule. He may, for example, work six hours, or as little as fifteen minutes. He may work five days a week or one.
