The Math Lab is designed to assist all HFCC students who need help with their math problems, from remedial to advanced. The lab is not only intended for students enrolled in mathematics courses. Any HFCC student, part-time or full-time, may use our services on a drop-in basis.

PROGRAMS

Programs are available in many different areas of mathematics, including arithmetic, algebra and trigonometry. The study materials include audio tapes, computer programs, video tapes, programmed books, and traditional texts.

Although a mathematics teacher will be available during the hours posted for the Math Lab, the programs were chosen for the independent learner. A student may study a particular topic, say factoring, according to his or her own schedule. The student may, for example, work six hours in the Lab, or as little as fifteen minutes. He or she may work four days a week or one.
